

## Telelag Trip to the Wind Lake Area

Following our annual meeting Saturday morning the Telelag will be going on a field trip to the Wind Lake area. Here we will visit the Wind Lake Lutheran Church Museum, which is the second church built on the site of the original log Muskego Church, which was moved to the Lutheran Seminary in St. Paul.

The museum at the old church houses some artifacts from the original log church such as a chalice, hand-carved burial spade, wooden collection box, articles and pictures of the history, a violin played by Ole Bull, some Lincoln memorabilia, handmade bunad, some related items for sale, and more. The sanctuary is used for services in the summer months and it is well preserved.

We will also visit Heg Memorial Park, a very well maintained park with a shelter, statue of Colonel Hans Heg of the Fifteenth Wisconsin Regiment, Heg's barn and the restored home of Pastor Ellingson.
